Westbrook Lakes Homeowners Association Pool Rules

- 1. Current pool tags are required to enter. Each member must have a tag. Guests must be accompanied by a member who is at least 15 years of age. Members who have guests must sign them in and be responsible for them at all times.
- Children 10 years old and under must be accompanied and supervised by an adult of 18 years or older at all times. Lifeguards are not responsible for supervision of underage children.
- 3. The Wading Pool is for children up to 5 years old and must be accompanied and supervised by an adult of 18 years or older at all times.
- 4. No diving into the pool.
- 5. All swimmers <u>must</u> wear bathing suits no cut-off jeans allowed. Modest swimwear is recommended, keep in mind this is a family pool.
- 6. Children in diapers <u>must</u> wear swim diapers.
- 7. Swim shoes must be worn in swimming area.
- 8. No bicycles, skateboards or other vehicles allowed in the pool area.
- 9. No pets, except seeing-eye dogs, are allowed on the premises.
- 10. No dangerous items such as tennis balls, Frisbees, etc. allowed in the pool area.
- 11. The use of cocoa butter, baby oil and other heavy suntan oils causes filter damage. It is advised that these lotions are not permitted in the pool.
- 12. No loud, abusive or vulgar language allowed.
- 13. No loud music allowed.
- 14. No electrical cords. Battery operated devices only at a low volume.
- 15. No alcoholic beverages allowed.
- 16. No glass containers allowed.
- 17. No food, drinks or gum in the pool.
- 18. No loitering.
- 19. No trespassing. Use of the pool after closing time is not permitted unless approved by Pool Management and a certified lifeguard employed by the pool management company has been paid to be on duty.
- 20. No running or horseplay in pool area.
- 21. Toys of soft materials are allowed at the lifeguard's discretion.
- 22. No oversized floating devices. Their use will be left to the lifeguard's discretion.
- 23. Failure to follow the rules may result in immediate removal from the pool area and charges may be filed with the Harris County Sheriff Department.
- 24. The lifeguards on duty have full authority to enforce all rules pertaining to the safety of the pool.
